



Montana Bandmasters Association Music Scholarship

The Montana Bandmaster Association (MBA) recognizes the need for good band directors in the state of Montana. In order to further this belief the MBA has established a scholarship in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00). It will be awarded to a graduating high school senior who will be going on to become a band director.

THE APPLICANT MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

1. Must be a high school graduate entering music education **in a Montana** university or college.
2. Must major on a wind or percussion instrument.
3. Must submit a written or typed application with two letters of recommendation selected from the following:
 - a. Current band director
 - b. Administrator or faculty member
 - c. Private music instructor
4. Must have maintained at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA in high school.
5. Submit a current transcript of grades.
6. Student's band director must be a member in good standing of the MBA.

Payment will be made following the end of the first semester provided the student has fulfilled the above criteria. If the principal recipient does not qualify, the scholarship will go to the second place finalist.

Applications are to be postmarked by **May 15, 2018**. Applicants shall be notified by May 31, 2018 if they have been selected as the scholarship recipient. All application materials should be sent to:
