#### **DEVELOP PIANO SKILLS**

Simple Up 5/Down 5

#### **BREATHING**

Mouthpiece

Slide without outer slide

Horn with no mouthpiece

Horn with mouthpiece

'Candle'

Music on the stand - blow it off!

"Cup of Water" vs. 'Expansion"

#### **POSITION**

Hand position - Sipping Tea with Grandma

Left Hand – Don't crush!

(Easter Eggs)

#### **TENSION POINTS**

**EXTERNAL** 

**Fingers** 

Wrist

Arms (too close to the body)

**Shoulders** 

Neck (have the horn come to YOU)

INTERNAL

Jaw

Teeth

Tongue

**Throat** 

#### **CHOPS**

The 'Mask'

4 Points

Pencil Trick

**Obnoxious Gliss** 

Ascending

Descending

#### SLIDE MOVEMENT

Quick, Rhythmic and AS LATE AS POSSIBLE

#### **RANGE**

More Gas and keep it Supple

#### STEPS TO PRACTICING

Finger

Blow and Slide

**Hidden Notes** 

Buzz

Sing

'Slop'

Octave below

Play on one note

Flutter tongue

#### **SCALE PATTERNS**

Trombones keep half steps together Common Alternates for Trombone

Bb in 5<sup>th</sup>

F in 6<sup>th</sup>

D in 4<sup>th</sup>

F in 4<sup>th</sup>

#### **SCALE PATTERN FUN!**

Thirds (1,3 2,4 3,5)

Diatonic Pattern A (1,2,3,1 2,3,4,2 3,4,5,3)

Ascending Triads (1,3,5 2,4,6)

Diatonic Pattern B (1,3,2,1 2,4,3,2 3,5,4,3)

Alternating Triads (1,3,5 6,4,2 3,5,7 8,6,4)

Inverted Thirds (1,3,4,2 3,5,6,4 5,7,8,6) \*Ascending Only

Fourths (1,4 2,5 3,6 4,7)

Inverted Fourths (1,4 5,2 3,6 7,4)

#### ARTICULATIONS

'Doo'

'Dah'

Stay away from speaking with vowels (bah, fah, etc.)
